Maria Pardalis founded Pardalis Music Studio (now Pardalis Studio for Music and Performing Arts) in the early 70s. She was an inspirational teacher who was able to trace her teachers to Chopin and Francis Clark.

Maria taught for over 30 years until her death in 2002. She was a popular workshop technician in the beginner method The Music Tree and served on many committees for piano festivals.

As well, she served as president of the Registered Music Teachers Association South Fraser Branch and had held many executive positions in the Vancouver branch.

One thing that she would always share with her students was to remember, “No musical mistake is a mistake, but rather a journey to create beautiful music”. Maria’s daughters are honoured to continue the tradition.

School Year

Lessons run from **September through June** and include approximately **40 lessons** throughout the school year.

Tuition

Tuition reserves your child's weekly lesson time and is divided into equal monthly payments. Monthly tuition remains the same regardless of the number of lessons in a particular month.

Payments

Tuition is due on either the **5th or the 15th** of each month. A **\$25 late fee** will be applied to overdue accounts.

Missed Lessons

Tuition is non-refundable. Make-up lessons may be offered at the teacher's discretion and are subject to availability.

Holidays & Breaks

Statutory holidays are observed. Christmas Break and Spring Break (Studio takes Spring Break over Greek Easter) are already factored into the annual lesson schedule.

Materials & Events

A yearly materials fee may apply for beginner students to cover books, supplementary materials, and photocopies. Participation in festivals, examinations, workshops, and performance opportunities is optional but strongly encouraged.

Current students will continue at their existing tuition rate. The above tuition applies to all new registrations beginning September 2026
